INTERNATIONAL BESPOKE PACKAGES

WHAT WE DO

Autism Clinic London provides consultant-led Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) assessments for children between the ages of 2 and 12 years. Our assessments are recognised around the world. We provide special packages for international families wanting the reassurance of an assessment provided by an accredited Harley Street clinic.

We take care of everything required for you and your child including accommodation within walking distance of our Harley Street Clinic, airport transfers, as well as suggested family activities during downtime. Typically, we recommend a three-night stay for the assessment although we can accommodate both longer and shorter stays if needed.

OUR PROCESS

Our fully tailored service starts with an initial virtual session before you leave your home country. During this call, we will ask for your consent to speak to your child's teachers before you travel. We will take care of each and every step for you whilst you are in the UK. All you need to do is book flights to and from a London airport.



DAY ONE

On the day of your arrival at a London Airport, we will arrange for a private transfer to a five-star hotel, a short walk from our Harley Street Clinic. Our standard package allows for two parents or carers and your child staying in a family room but this can be adjusted as needed.

No commitments are made on your time on arrival day allowing you to arrive, get settled and relax.

DAY TWO

An internationally recognised ADOS-2 assessment is conducted by one of our specialist clinicians at our Harley Street Clinic. We can accommodate a wide variety of languages. If needed, we can also provide an interpreter for other languages.

The assessment will last up to an hour leaving you the rest of the day to return to your hotel to relax or we can book family activities for you.

DAY THREE

A consultant paediatrician will observe your child as well as carry out a comprehensive physical and developmental assessment. You will then have an interview with your consultant who will take a detailed history of your child. This assessment will last up to two and a half hours.

The outcome of all of the assessments will be shared with you along with a support package specific to your child's needs.

AFTER YOU'VE LEFT

A comprehensive report will be emailed securely to you within one week highlighting your child's strengths and needs.

We appreciate that for some, the diagnosis can be overwhelming and it can be hard to find credible information. Once you have returned home, our clinician will conduct a 30-minute video call with you to answer your questions about autism and the ongoing support we offer.

FAMILY FRIENDLY FUN

London is home to some of the world's finest museums and cultural landmarks as well as spectacular entertainment. We allow plenty of downtime so as not to overwhelm you and your child. Below are some of our recommendations but we can accommodate other requests such as cinema or theatre tickets.



SEA LIFE

Dive into SEA LIFE London Aquarium. Discover over 6,000 creatures including a colony of Gentoo penguins, 2 adorable Green Sea Turtles, and the UK's largest jellyfish display. A sensory experience, with many sights, sounds and smells. Occasionally there are characters that will roam different areas including Rainforest Rangers, costume character Roxo the Penguin and others.

LONDON ZOO

London Zoo welcomes everyone to enjoy time connecting with wildlife. Their aim is to ensure everybody has a great day out that is accessible for people of all needs and abilities. Discover amazing wildlife, learn how we're protecting their future and share incredible memories of our leaping, roaring, squawking natural world.

YOUNG V&A

Young V&A focuses on being a dedicated space for young children until teens, with lots of activities. It also includes lots of exhibits such as Sky Brown's Olympic skateboard.

For visitors with learning disabilities and dyslexia, it also offers a guiding service which can be booked in advance. You'll also find assistive tech, and kids can use ear defenders, available at the entrance.

BUCKINGHAM PALACE

Gain entry to the royal palace via the quieter "Access" Entrance.

Catering for visitors on the Autism Spectrum you will be able to avoid the queues.

Please note that when you are inside the State Rooms you join the standard visitor route, which can get very busy.

DAWNOSAURS

The Natural History Museum in nearby Kensington is perfect for kids who love dinosaurs, creepy crawlies or butterflies. It's as vast as it is impressive. Dawnosaurs events are especially for children with neurodiverse conditions. These events are kept free of the general public and are much quieter. Visitors get access to a wide range of galleries and activities, all supported by autism-aware facilitators.

EARLY BIRDS

The Science Museum, invites you to explore outer and inner space with Early Birds; this is a sensory-friendly event for families with members who need a quieter, calming setting — and that includes autism spectrum conditions or sensory processing differences.

You can catch these on Saturdays and Sundays across the year.

HOTELS

Our two recommended 5-star hotels offer a striking contrast of contemporary chic and traditional elegance, but both with excellent accommodations for families and groups. Transfers to and from the hotel and the cost of your rooms is included in the price of your assessment.



THE BOTREE

Stylish and contemporary, The BoTree has a prime London location where Marylebone, Mayfair, and Soho meet. Oxford Street and Bond Street are a short walk away, as is Hyde Park. Our Harley Street Clinic is just around the corner.

The sophisticated interconnecting rooms and suites are ideal for families. The interiors are bright, modern and feature a focus on natural materials.
